Métis Bev June 19th

Métis Bev teaches the basic components of the Red River Jig. The Red River Jig is the most famous Métis dance and is the centrepiece of the Métis music. Métis jigging is known to incorporate elements of First Nations powwow dancing and European styles, such as tap and Highland dance.
