I hope everyone had a good summer. We had such great weather that it felt like we got a real summer. I spent the majority of mine outdoors, either picking berries, working in the garden or herding chickens. Our chicken flock expanded exponentially over the summer, from 9 to 30. A lot of our time we devoted to our bees as well. We went from 4 hives that made it through last winter to 13 hives right now. It was a great summer, and I am ready to get back into routines and seeing your kiddos every day!

Don Titus students do not need to purchase school supplies. All supplies are provided for a supply fee. Primary students pay \$30.00 and intermediate students pay \$50.00. These fees can be paid anytime in September. You can pay with cash, cheque, or e-transfer to <u>dtms@sd59.bc.ca</u> If paying by e transfer please write in the memo box who the fees are for. Students should bring a re-usable water bottle and indoor shoes that don't make black marks on the floor and that they can put on by themselves.

There will be lots of forms and information going home this first week. The package of forms that need to be returned is very important for a number of reasons. First, it asks for updated contact information. This is essential if we need to get a hold of you. Second, there are district forms that need to be completed in order for students to be able to access the internet, apps on the IPads, etc. Third, these forms tell us whether or not students are allowed to be photographed and the pictures shared on our Facebook page. Lastly, there is a form for allowing students to attend field trips within walking distance of the school, for example, walking to see rocks at the creek, cleaning up garbage across the road, or hiking the trails behind the school. We've tried to streamline the package so that only one per family needs to be completed. You can look for these to go home on Thursday.

When students go to their classes on Wednesday, we will be very clear with them that this might not be where they stay. Our configuration is not final until the end of September and there will likely be some changes made in the first few weeks.

We will be starting Pizza Sales on Monday Sept. 9th. Pizza is sold by the slice for \$3.00. The choices are cheese or pepperoni. The pizza comes from 7-11. Students bring money and order in the morning and the proceeds of all pizza sales goes towards field trip bussing for all classes. This will happen every Monday unless announced in the weekly memo.
