Interested in Being A Volunteer Driver?

If you are interested in being a volunteer driver for school activities such as sports teams, there are district processes that need to be followed.

These include, providing copies of required paperwork including a copy of your current insurance for the vehicle you will be transporting students in with a minimum of one million dollars liability, a clear drivers abstract, a valid drivers license and completion of a volunteer driver meeting with the principal to go over the district rules for transporting students in a private vehicle.

Students being transported by a volunteer driver for a school activity need to have a signed school permission form on file at the office.

Arriving late? Leaving Early? Not Riding the Bus?
