## PARENTS AT SCHOOL

## Safety of Students (Including Higher Risk Activities) Regulation 4555.10.3 tobogganing.

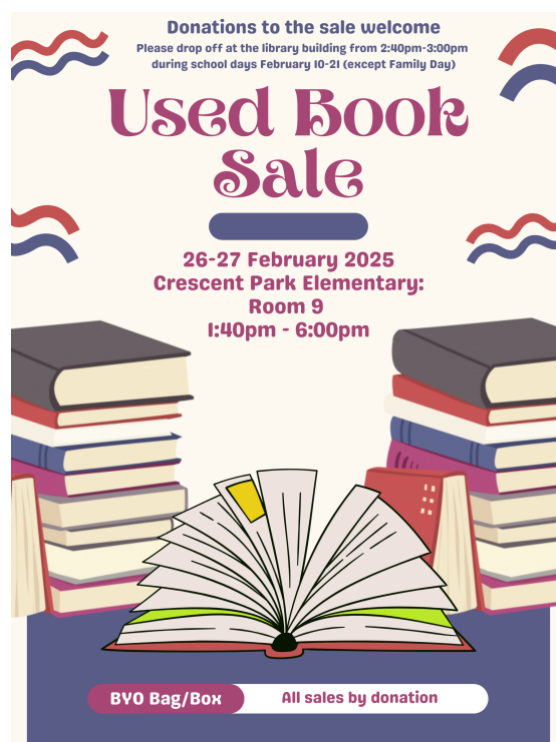
